

# Sussex Clubs for Young People Detached Youth Work Protocol

**Reviewed 24<sup>th</sup> November 2021**

- Safety of staff and young people is paramount.
- Staff to be clearly identified by uniform issued by SCYP and ID badge
- Staff to continually carry out dynamic risk assessments.
- Staff will carry a charged work mobile phone.
- Detached youth work practices for engaging young people should be followed.
- Detached teams can be 2 to 3 staff – no more – no fewer.
- Staff need to travel separately to a prearranged venue.
- Briefing on Risk Assessment and safety requirements to be completed with Team Manager.
- Session logs to be recorded directly after session complete with headcount.
- Any incidents/accidents must be recorded and actioned in line with policy.
- The session times need to be clearly identified and clarified with the Team Manager.
- Staff to check in with Team Manager at end of session.

## **COVID SAFETY**

- Staff to always observe appropriate social distancing from each other and young people. Wear masks as necessary.
- Where staff have concerns about a young person's health in relation to Covid 19 they should advise the young person to isolate at home and seek medical advice. Staff should then withdraw from the situation completely to reduce risk of contamination.

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
